The DUI MAT Integration/Outreach Project (DUI MAT) is one of over 26 projects in the California Mat Expansion Project, State Opioid Response (SOR) I-III, funded through federal and state grants from SAMHSA and DHCS to address the opioid and overdose crises in the State. The project meets the goal of creating new OUD and PolySUD treatment access points through integration with DUI Programs located throughout California. **Licensed DUI Programs are encouraged to apply for this opportunity!**

- ④ Project data defines the population of OUD and PolySUD persons who are reached through interaction with the DUI Treatment System.
- ④ The DUI MAT Project integrated in the DUI Program helps to reduce DUI recidivism, increase public safety on the roadways, and assists more people in accessing treatment for OUD and PolySUD.

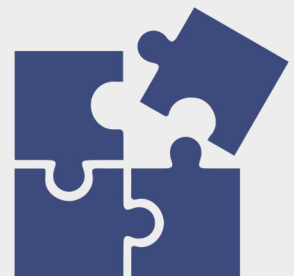
